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| Learning Goal | - Recognizes, observes, and discuss the relationship of organisms to their environments <br> - Asks and answer appropriate questions about the book <br> - Uses a wide variety of words to label and describe people, places things, and actions <br> - Demonstrates awareness of one-to-one relationships <br> - Counts up to ten items, with one count per item <br> - Counts up to ten items and demonstrates that the last count indicates how many items were counted <br> - Uses category labels to understand how words and objects relate to each other - Recognizes one-digit numerals 0 through 9 <br> - Uses a wide variety of words to label and describe people, places, things, and actions <br> - Uses category labels to understand how words and objects relate to each other - Uses information learned from books by describing, relating, categorizing, or comparing and contrasting <br> - Knows that objects or parts of an object can be counted <br> - Demonstrates that the order of the counting sequence is always the same regardless of what is counted | - 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
