

## **ILLNESS/MEDICATION PARENT NOTIFICATION**

Our license prohibits Crème de la Crème from accepting children into care when a child is presenting symptoms of illness.

Crème de la Crème is not licensed to care for ill children. Therefore, children may not attend Crème de la Crème exhibiting any of the following symptoms.

An oral temperature of 100° or higher or an armpit temperature of 99.4° or higher. (Must be fever-free, without fever reducers for 24 hours before returning to Crème de la Crème.)

Discharge from the eyes, ears or profuse colored nasal discharge. (May return to Crème de la Crème once the discharge is clear or the child has been on antibiotics for 24 – 48 hours according to your physician's instructions.)

Diarrhea. (May return to school once diarrhea has completely subsided for a minimum of 24 hours without medication.)

Vomiting. (May return to school once vomiting has completely subsided for a minimum of 24 hours without medication.)

An unusual rash. (May return to school with a physician's note stating a diagnosis and that the child is "not contagious".)

Unusual lethargy, irritability, is persistently crying, or has difficulty breathing. (May return to school when unusual lethargy, irritability, or persistent crying or difficulty breathing has completely subsided without medications.)

### **Medication Policy**

All prescription and non-prescription medications need to be accompanied with a note from the doctor giving Crème de la Crème permission to administer and directions to dispense.

Parents must complete required information and sign the "Authorization to Administer Medicine" form each week medication is to be dispensed.

All medication must be stored in the Infirmary in its original container. The medication container must have the child's name and instructions for dispensing clearly marked.
